Geotechnical reports and investigations (W.O. 7606) dated 1/2/89 conducted by Geo Labs for the development of this Tract showed that this area was used as a borrow site for fill soil for off-site projects from 1979-89. In certain areas sixty feet of soil was removed. No solid waste was encountered. All material was native soil. Additional trenches and borings for this Tract showed

all soil, no solid waste was encountered. Geotechnical reports are maintained at the City of Camarillo, Engineering Department. See attached summary for documentation on research. Site inspections by the LEA during February 1982 showed no evidence of solid waste at the former disposal area and surrounding subdivision.
