A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE LIST OF LOCAL MASTER ARCHITECTS AND BUILDERS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED COUNTY AREA, THE CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD SERVES

The Ventura County Cultural Heritage Board (CHB) hereby resolves, finds, determines and declares as follows:

- WHEREAS, the Ventura County Board of Supervisors adopted an Ordinance entitled the "Ventura County Cultural Heritage Ordinance No. 4225" on December 12, 2000 (CHO) that establishes a cultural heritage program, including criteria for nominating eligible historic properties; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to CHO Section 1365-5a, an improvement or site may be eligible for Cultural Heritage Site designation if it meets the following criterion: "It embodies a type, period, region or method of construction, or represents the work of a master or possesses high artistic values"; and
- WHEREAS, on November 13, 2017, the CHB held a public hearing to consider maintaining an official list, herein referenced as the List of Local Master Architects and Builders, that represents notable local builders, designers, or architects of consummate skill, or anonymous builders, designers or architects whose work is distinguishable from others by its characteristic style and quality in the Unincorporated areas of the County.
- WHEREAS, on November 13, 2017, the CHB reviewed the List of Local Master Architects and Builders and finds that this list is compiled to assist staff in the identification and evaluation of properties throughout the County for historical significance; and
- WHEREAS, on November 13, 2017, the CHB finds the List of Local Master Architects and Builders may be used to assist staff in screening development proposals on properties that are undesignated but possess architectural merit;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the CHB hereby authorizes the adoption of the List of Local Master Architects and Builders attached hereto as Exhibit A, for use, as appropriate in identifying and evaluating undesignated properties for historical significance, subject to any recommended changes to the list made by the CHB.
