Temporary Waiver of Solid Waste Facility Permit Terms – Simi Valley Landfill & Recycling Center

Date of Notice: October 8, 2024

The Environmental Health Division (Division) as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has received and approved a request for temporary waiver of solid waste facilities permit terms (Waiver) for the Simi Valley Landfill and Recycling Center (SVLRC).

The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Ventura, including all active landfills and transfer stations.

Description of Request and LEA's Determination

The SVLRC is located at 2801 Madera Road, Simi Valley, CA 93065. On October 3, 2024, the LEA received an official request for a temporary waiver of terms of the solid waste facilities permit to accommodate the immediate disposal needs of the public due to the likely reduction in volume or temporary closure of the Chiquita Canyon Landfill (SWIS No. 19-AA-0052) at the end of October 2024.

The temporary Waiver allows SVLRC to do the following:

- Increase the maximum daily tonnage of municipal solid waste from 12,000 tons per day (TPD) to 17,000 TPD.
- Increase the maximum daily cap of municipal solid waste and recyclables from 8,000 TPD to 17,000 TPD.

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• Increase the maximum weekly tonnage of municipal solid waste from 64,750 tons per week to 119,000 tons per week.

The LEA found that an unforeseeable temporary emergency exists, as defined in Title 14 California Code of Regulations, Section 17211.1(b), due to the impact of increased disposal demands on other solid waste facilities surrounding the Chiquita Canyon Landfill and approved the temporary Waiver request on October 8, 2024.
